Why

Due Diligence of potential partners and market analysis is standard procedure when expanding business. The same should apply when looking at the political, economic and societal background of the geographical target of such expansion: *geopolitical due diligence* is thus part of overall evaluation of risks but also new business potential.

Black swans, unforeseen events nullifying all previous analysis and calculations, lose at least part of their sting with proper application of *geopolitical due diligence*, e.g. potential sanctions also against China in the wake of the war in the Ukraine.

How
